

## Convenience Center Guidelines

- Lee County's Convenience Centers are open to **County residents only**. Proof of residency is required.
- City of Sanford residents should call 919-775-8247 and Town of Broadway residents should call 919-258-9922 for solid waste information.
- No commercial, industrial or institutional waste is accepted.
- Loitering and/or scavenging is prohibited.
- All non-recyclable household garbage must be bagged.
- Tires (no more than 5) are accepted at the Resource Management Facility.
- Yard waste including leaves, grass and brush is accepted at the Resource Management Facility.

## Construction and Demolition Waste

Building wastes including lumber, sheetrock, siding, shingles, insulation, doors & windows, wall to wall carpet and fixtures are not accepted at the Convenience Centers. These wastes can be taken to one of the following:

## ONE BIN RECYCLING

# THE FOLLOWING ITEMS CAN ALL BE PLACED IN THE SAME BIN

Please rinse containers of any excess food.

### PLASTIC

All bottles, containers, jugs & rigid plastics



### METAL

Aluminum, Steel & Tin Cans



### PAPER

All mixed paper, newspaper, magazines, books, junk mail, cartons & envelopes



### GLASS

All Bottles & Jars



## ALSO ACCEPTED FOR RECYCLING

The following materials can be placed in separate bins. Ask attendant for assistance



### Corrugated Cardboard

Please breakdown and flatten boxes



### White Goods & Scrap Metal

Appliances and other large metal items. Refrigerators and freezers must be empty of all contents.



### Electronics

Computers, TVs and anything with a cord.



### Motor Oil, Oil Filters & Anti-Freeze

Also can include: Transmission fluid, Hydraulic fluid, Diesel Fuel, Kerosene  
Do not mix Anti-freeze with other fluids.



### Other Recyclables

Lead Acid & Rechargeable Batteries, Ink Jet & Toner Cartridges, Fluorescent Light Bulbs and Cell Phones

## Accepted for Disposal:

Bagged Household Garbage & Bulky Items (Furniture, Mattresses, etc.)



## DO NOT INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING ITEMS WITH ABOVE RECYCLABLES:

- Plastic Bags
- Styrofoam
- Clothing or Shoes
- Window or Mirror Glass
- Hazardous Wastes
- Liquid Wastes
- Anti-Freeze & Motor Oil
- Light Bulbs
- Batteries
- Household garbage
- Dishes or ceramic mugs
